The age ratings for popular social media apps and online games are put in place to keep all children safe.

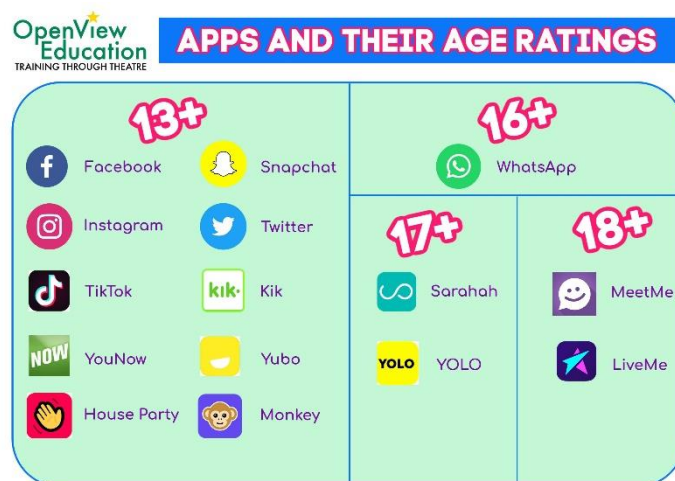

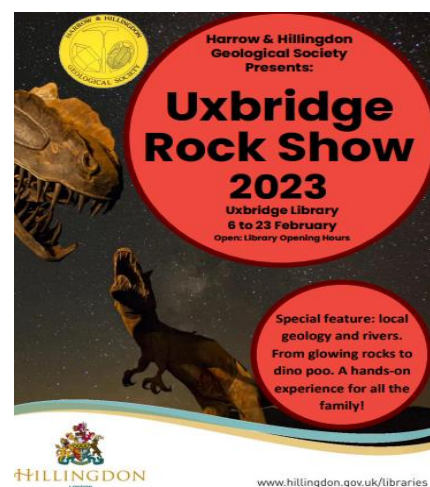
